Support Student Organizations

- Create more specialty committees open to all students that focus on key issues like parking, mental health, etc.
- Conduct more outreach with student organizations to build long-term partnerships and better advocate for their interests
- Utilize the University Student Fee Committee to push for student budget increases like the SOC Organization fund
- Organize student groups to better collaborate on initiatives and push for large-scale change at UT Dallas
- Secure more spaces for student organizations to host events and meetings
- Spread awareness of and encourage student organizations to utilize the Greenfund as a source of funding for student-first sustainability projects

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Protect Student Rights

- Coordinate the student body to respond to hostile entities such as ICE and support undocumented, international, and other “at-risk” student populations by spreading awareness of free resources
- Create strong bridges between Student Government and elected officials to better advocate for students outside of UT Dallas
- Prevent and fight crackdowns on student expression and speech
- Revise the Student Affairs disciplinary system to be more impartial, transparent, and utilize truly unbiased 3rd parties
- Devising comprehensive plans to address the needs of LGBTQ+ students preceding and following the passage of harmful laws
- Utilize UT SAC (University of Texas System Student Advisory Council) to coordinate UT System wide responses to attacks on student rights such as drag bans, bathroom access, etc.

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Hold Admin Accountable

- Continue and expand the “Budget Breakdown” transparency initiative to larger organizations such as the UT System
- Coordinate and utilize student representation on University-Wide Committees that oversee and set university policies
- Continue Student Government transparency initiatives like publishing budget reports and recording meetings
- Prevent further cancellation of student programs like the Track and Field and Cross Country teams and push for student consultation before large decisions are made

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Student Health & Wellness

- Support and expand the residential Narcan program, menstrual product access on campus, emergency contraception ease of access, free grad gown closet program, and health vending machine operations
- Ensure trans students have ongoing access to update their names and pronouns on educational platforms, gender-neutral bathrooms, and discussions on expansive gender identity in classrooms
- Reach out to key student stakeholders to better advocate for specific campus changes like harmful policy, accessibility concerns, etc.
- Work with the Office of Student Success to recreate and release the Student Wellness Survey
- Fight student hunger by creating a long-lasting partnership with the Comet Cupboard
- Push for continued coverage and expansion of DART operations at UT Dallas
